

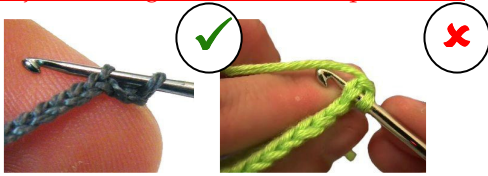


Introduction:

- ☉ Size:
Depends on the yarn and hook sizes you are using, approximately 4.5 cm / 1.75".
- ☉ Skill level:
Beginner.
You should be familiar with crocheting in rounds and basic stitches.

There are no basic crochet tutorials included.

Belarusian Flag

Step-by-step detailed tutorial

Materials:

- ☉ 3 colors of yarn (#10): red, white and green
- ☉ Crochet hook, size 1 mm.
- ☉ Akrilon or other type of fiberfill.
- ☉ Scissors
- ☉ Needle.

Abbreviations and symbols:

- ☉ Ch – chain, symbol O.
- ☉ SC – Single Crochet, X.
- ☉ Rnd – Round.

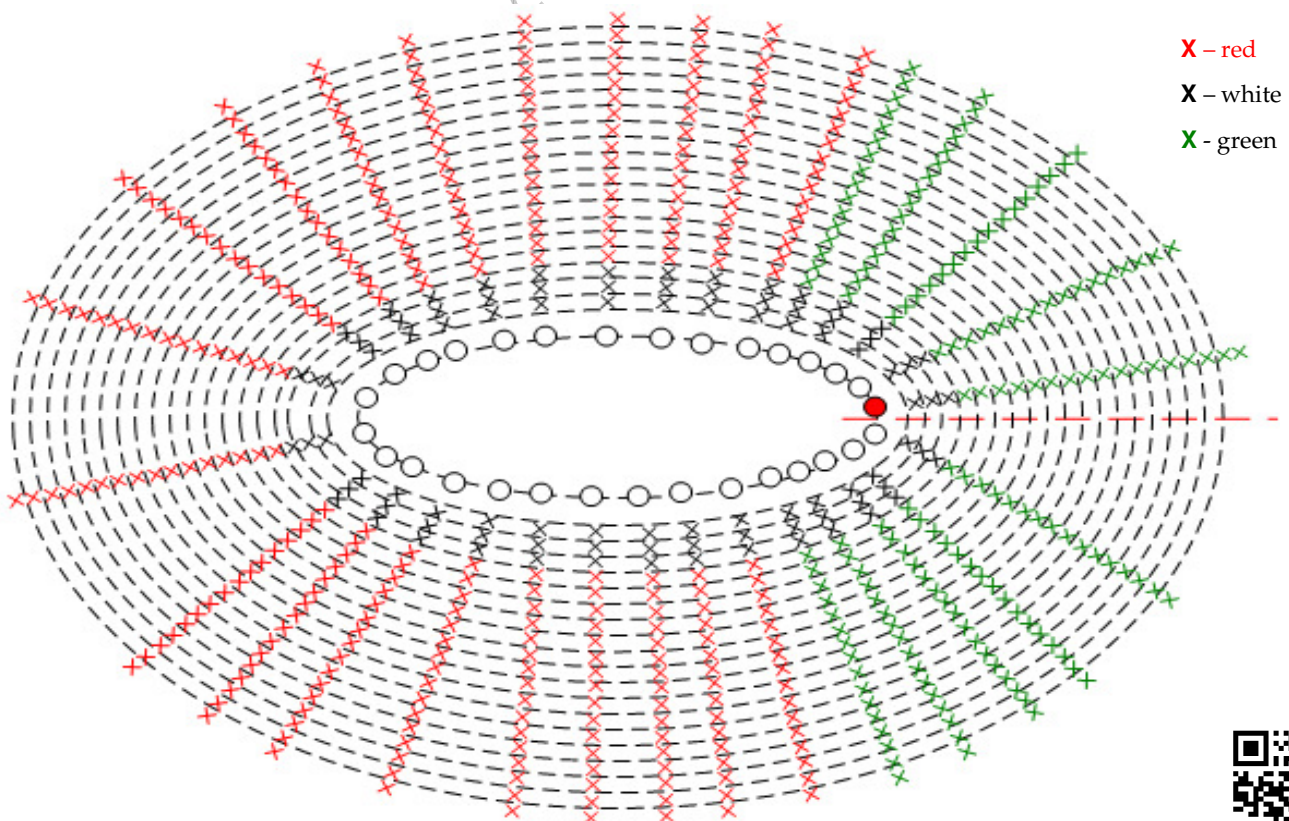
Important Note:

- ☉ Please read the graphic chart counter-clockwise.
- ☉ The remaining project will be worked in continuous rounds (spirals), so there's no joining at the end of the round. You also may wish to use a marker to keep track of your rounds.
- ☉ Red dot indicates the first chain.
- ☉ **Continue crochet counter-clockwise, do not turn the inside out at the end of the project**

Small American Flag:

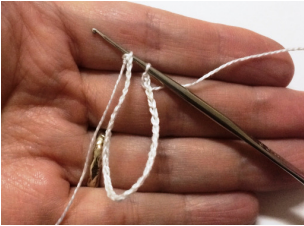
- ☉ Start with the red color.
- ☉ Read the graphic chart counter-clockwise.
- ☉ Red dot indicates the first chain.





Marina Levy's Handmade Crafts

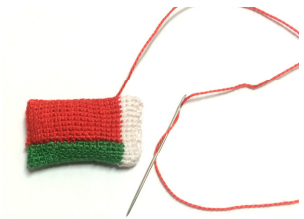
- Rnd 1: Leave a long tail of the white thread. Crochet 30 Ch and join it to the loop by crocheting 1 SC.



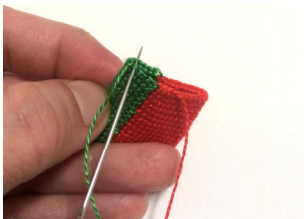
- Rnd 2-4 : 1 SC in next 30 SC (4 white rnds total).



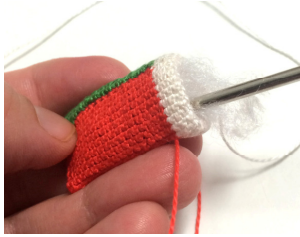
- Rnd 5 - 21 Change the color to green and crochet 1 SC in next 5 SC. Leave a long tail of red color. Change the color to red and crochet 1 SC in next 20 SC. Then change the color to green and crochet 1 SC in next 5 SC - 30 SC in total.



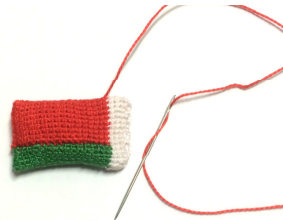
- Sew the "bottom" and the upper part of the flag. Knot and secure the tail of the thread.



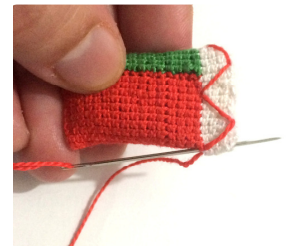
- Stuff the flag with fiberfill. Use the back end of crochet hook to reach the edges. Do not make a puffy body, keep it flat.



- Squeeze the flag a little to spread the fiberfill equally
- Sew the bottom part of the flag. Knot and secure the tail of the thread.



- Use the red thread to make the national ornament



- Insert the ring



There you go: Belarusian flag!
